## Cycle training delivery in **2023-24**



Bikeability Scotland is the national cycle training programme for school children. Delivered by trained instructors, it helps children build the skills and confidence they need to cycle on today's roads.



**2/3** primary schools delivered Bikeability Scotland training - benefiting **54,039** young people

**1/2** of all local authorities now deliver on-road cycle training in over **85%** of their primary schools



**60%** of primary schools offered on-road (Level 2) cycle training



A **record number** of Scottish councils (10) delivered on-road cycle training at every primary school in their area
