Options and costs

1. Corporate space

Exhibitor A - £950

- Large space, allowing for stands, table, three chairs, pop-ups, spider stands
- Two tickets for conference including lunch and refreshments
- Power supply to allow for screens etc.
- Logo on screen in the main hall

Exhibitor B - £750

- Space for table, two chairs and one pop-up
- Two tickets for conference including lunch and refreshments
- Logo on screen in the main hall

2. Public sector, third-sector and social enterprise: £400

- Space for table, two chairs and one pop-up
- Two tickets for conference including lunch and refreshments
- Logo on screen in main hall

3. Voluntary organisations: £100

- Space for table, two chairs and one pop-up
- One ticket for conference including lunch and refreshments
- Logo on screen in main hall

Venue

<u>DoubleTree by Hilton (Glasgow Central)</u> 36 Cambridge St Glasgow, G2 3HN

The venue is fully accessible and has free WiFi.

It's a short cycle or walk from both Glasgow Queen Street and Central stations. Cycle storage is available. We encourage everyone to use active or public transport but if you do need to drive, the hotel has a car park on a first-come-first-served basis. The discounted rate for those attending an event is £10 for all day access. Guests need to register their vehicles with reception and pay directly to receive the discounted rate.

Set-up: access from 16.00 – 21.00 on Monday 7th October Event day (Tuesday 8th October):

08.00: open for additional exhibitor set-up

09.00: registration and exhibition hall open to delegates. Exhibitors must have their stands set up and ready for registration by 09.00.

The exhibition runs throughout the day and delegates will spend time in the exhibitor area during registration, mid-morning, lunch and afternoon breaks

16.00: close and dismantle
